

## **TRI-COLLEGIATE DENTAL MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATIONS**

### **EXAMINER ASSESSOR – PERSON SPECIFICATION**

#### **1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Must be a current member of a Specialty Membership examination panel of one of the three Colleges (this does not need to be one of the Tri-Collegiate panels) - or have stood down from one of these panels within the last three years.
- Must have been a member of the above panel for at least 3 years
- Must have examined on at least five occasions
- Must be on a GDC Specialist List

#### **2. PERSON SPECIFICATION**

In addition to meeting the eligibility criteria, Assessors must show commitment to

- High professional standards as an examiner, including understanding of appropriate techniques and a policy of courtesy, fairness and non-discrimination towards all candidates and fellow examiners
- Competence in and loyalty to the relevant profession
- Commitment to the examination process, i.e. honouring commitments to attend examinations, except in exceptional circumstances

#### **3. TRAINING**

All Assessors must undertake a Tri-Collegiate training programme before commencing assessor duties.

#### **4. PERIOD OF TENURE**

Assessors will normally serve for a period of five years.
