CAREER DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK FOR CONSULTANT APPOINTMENT IN PAEDIATRIC DENTISTRY

Specialty Advisory Committee for Paediatric Dentistry
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Paediatric Dentistry is the practice and teaching of, and research into the comprehensive therapeutic oral health care for children from birth through adolescence, including care for those who demonstrate intellectual, medical, physical, psychological and/or emotional problems. In the United Kingdom (UK), a Specialist List, held by the General Dental Council (GDC), enables the identification of registered dentists who have been given the right (by the GDC) to use the title 'Specialist in Paediatric Dentistry'. The award of a Certificate of Completion of Specialist Training (CCST) in Paediatric Dentistry requires evidence of satisfactory completion of training as detailed in the relevant GDC-approved curriculum document.

It is recognised that CCST holders employed as substantive and honorary consultants in the NHS are required not only to practise core specialist skills but also to possess a range of additional competencies. Demonstration of the following learning outcomes is considered a prerequisite for consultant appointment.

The prescribed length of preparation for consultant employment is flexible and dependent upon demonstration of the requisite learning outcomes. It is anticipated, however, that, taken as a whole, specialist training and preparation for consultant employment should occupy no more than 5 years WTE.
