Direct Observation of Procedural Skills (Surgical DOPS)

Trainer/Trainee Guidance Points

These guidance points are to be used in conjunction with point 6 ('performs the technical aspects in line with the guidance notes') on the main Surgical DOPS form. A mark should <u>not</u> be given for each of these points – they should instead be used to inform the mark to be given for point 6.

Specialty: Orthodontics

Procedure: Interproximal enamel reduction

Steps to be performed

- 1. Explains to the patient what is going to happen at that appointment
- 2. Ensures appropriate instruments and materials are readily available
- 3. Appropriate planning to include a) site selection (shape of tooth), b) quantity of reduction, c) selection of IPR instrument and explain choices to assessor
- 4. Ensure soft tissue retraction and protection
- 5. Demonstrates appropriate reduction
- 6. Demonstrates appropriate contouring
- 7. Demonstrates appropriate polishing
- 8. Ensures follow up instructions are provided to the patient
- 9. Ensures clinical records are completed correctly and follow-up is arranged
- Ensures appropriate cross-infection techniques observed throughout the entire observed period
- 11. Demonstrates high standards of professionalism throughout the entire observed period
- 12. Demonstrates good communication (including instructions when required) throughout the entire observed period
- 13. Ensures safe clinical practice throughout the entire observed period
